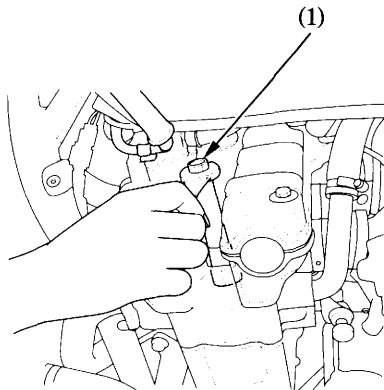


1. Remove the seat (page 73 ).
2. Raise the fuel tank (page 79 ).
3. Disconnect the spark plug caps from the spark plugs.
4. Clean any dirt from around the spark plug bases.

Remove the spark plugs using the spark plug wrench ( 1 ) furnished in the tool kit.

5. Inspect the electrodes and center porcelain for deposits, erosion or carbon fouling. If the erosion or deposit is heavy, replace the plug. Clean a carbon or wet-fouled plug with a plug cleaner, otherwise use a wire brush.
