
- 12. Disconnect the spark plug caps from the spark plugs.
- 13. Clean any dirt from around the spark plug bases. Remove the spark plugs using the plug wrench (10) furnished in the tool kit.
- 14. Inspect the electrodes and center porcelain for deposits, erosion or cabon fouling. If the erosion or deposit is heavy, replace the plug. Clean a carbon or wetfouled plug with a plug cleaner.
