
Final drive gear oil change:

- 1. Remove the oil filler cap 1 (page 43).
- 2. Place drain pan under the final drive gear case to catch the oil, and then remove the oil drain plug '3.

WARNING: When draining or filling, take care not to allow foreign materials to enter the case and not to allow the gear oil to contaminate the tire and wheel.

- 3. After the oil stops draining from the gear case, rotate the rear wheel by hand to drain any oil which may be left in the recesses of the case.
- 4. When the oil has been completely drained, reinstall the drain plug ³ securely, making sure that the plain washer is in good condition.

- 5. Fill the gear case up to filler neck with fresh oil of the recommended grade. See page 24.
- Oil capacity: $6.8 \sim 7.5$ ozs. $(200 \sim 220 \text{ cc})$ 6. Reinstall the filler cap securely.
