## **Parking Brake**

Parking brake adjustment may be required if the parking brake does not hold properly.

## Parking Brake Adjustment:

- Remove the fuel tank cap breather tube (1) from the handlebar cover.
- 2. Remove the two dust caps (2), the two screws (3) and the handle-bar cover (4).



- 3. Temporarily adjust the clutch lever free play to more than 30 mm (1.2 in) (page 107).
- 4. Loosen the lock nut (1) on the parking brake cable, and screw in the adjuster (2) completely.
- 5. Loosen the lock nut (3) on the parking brake arm (4) and turn the adjusting bolt (5) clockwise until you feel resistance.
- 6. Then turn the adjusting bolt (5) 1/8 counterclockwise, and tighten the lock nut (3).


