

6. Wash the filter in nonflammable or high flash point solvent and allow it to dry thoroughly.

## **▲ WARNING**

### **POTENTIAL HAZARD**

***Using gasoline or low flash point solvents for cleaning ATV parts.***

### **WHAT CAN HAPPEN**

**A fire or explosion could result.**

### **HOW TO AVOID THE HAZARD**

**Use only a nonflammable or high flash point solvent for cleaning ATV parts.**

7. Soak the filter in Pro Honda Foam Filter oil or an equivalent until saturated, then squeeze out the excess oil.

### **CAUTION:**

**Do not twist the filter element when squeezing out excess oil. Twisting could damage the filter.**

8. Reassemble by reversing the disassembly sequence.
