- 2. Remove the seat (page 146).
- 3. Remove the rear fender lid (page 125).
- 4. Remove the fuse box cover (page 127).
- 5. Pull the old fuse out of the clips.
- 6. Push a new fuse into the clips and install the fuse box cover.
- 7. Install the rear fender lid.
- 8. Install the seat.



## To replace the sub fuses:

1. Make sure the ignition switch is OFF ( O ).

## CAUTION:

Turn the ignition switch OFF (  $\bigcirc$  ) before checking or replacing the fuse to prevent accidental short-circuiting which could damage the electrical system.
