Engine Idle Speed and Air-Fuel Mixture

6. Adjust idle speed by turning the throttle stop screw (2). Idle speed (in neutral):

 $1.400 \pm 100 \, \text{min}^{-1} \, (\text{rpm})$

7. Reinstall the right side cover.

Air-Fuel Mixture Adjustment

- 1. Before adjusting the air-fuel mixture, unsnap the right side cover (1).
- 2. Turn the pilot screw (3) clockwise until you hear the engine miss or decrease in speed.
- 3. Then turn the screw counterclockwise until the engine misses or decreases in speed again.
- 4. Centre the pilot screw exactly between the two extreme positions. Usually, the correct setting (between extremes of rich and lean) will be found at 1 turn open from a fully closed position.
- 5. If idle speed changes after adjusting the fuel mixture, readjust the throttle stop screw.
- 6. Reinstall the right side cover.
