

Pre-ride Inspection

To ensure safety, it is your responsibility to perform a pre-ride inspection and make sure that any problem you find is corrected. A pre-ride inspection is a must, not only for safety, but because having a breakdown, or even a flat tyre, can be a major inconvenience.

Check the following items before you get on your motorcycle:

- Fuel level-Fill fuel tank when necessary. ➔ P. 43
- Throttle-Check for smooth opening and full closing in all steering positions. ➔ P. 85
- Engine oil level-Add engine oil if necessary. Check for leaks. ➔ P. 72
- Coolant level-Add coolant if required. Check for leaks. ➔ P. 76

- Drive chain-Check condition and slack, adjust and lubricate if necessary. ➔ P. 57, 82
- Brakes-Check operation; Front and Rear: check brake fluid level and pads wear. ➔ P. 78
- Lights and horn-Check that lights, indicators and horn function properly.
- Engine stop switch-Check for proper function.
- Clutch-Check clutch fluid level. ➔ P. 80
- Side stand ignition cut-off system-Check for proper function. ➔ P. 81
- Wheels and tyres-Check condition, air pressure and adjust if necessary. ➔ P. 60
