## Drive Chain Inspection and adjustment:

- Place the motorcycle on its center stand, with the transmission in neutral and the ignition switch off.
- 2. Turn the rear wheel slowly, and inspect the drive chain and sprockets for damage, wear, dry or rust. Drive chain and/or sprocket(s) with damaged or worn must be replaced. Chain that appears dry or shows signs of rust requires supplemental lubrication.
- Move the chain (1) up and down with your fingers and measure the amount of slack. The slack should be adjusted to 15-25 mm (5/8-1 in.) and never be allowed to exceed 50 mm (2.0 in.).
- (A) Damaged sprocket teeth
- (B) Worn sprocket teeth
- (C) Normal sprocket teeth
