

Spark Plugs

2. Clean any dirt from around the spark plug bases.

Inspection

- 1. Disconnect the spark plug caps (3). Take care to avoid damaging the spark plug wire when disconnecting the caps.
- 2. Using a spark plug wrench (4), remove the spark plugs.


FRONT (Front Cylinder)

- Inspect the electrodes and center porcelain for deposits, corrosion, or carbon fouling. If the corrosion or deposits are heavy, replace the plug.
- 4. Using a 1.4 mm wire-type feeler gauge, check the spark plug gap (5) of each plug. The gauge should not fit in the gap. If it does fit, replace the plug with a new one.
