
Compression Damping:

This adjustment affects how quickly the fork compresses. The fork compression damping adjuster (1) has 14 positions (clicks) or more. Turning the adjuster screw one full turn changes the adjuster

4 positions. To adjust the adjuster to the standard position, proceed as follows:

- 1. Turn the damping adjuster clockwise until it will no longer turn (lightly seats). This is the full hard setting.
- 2. Turn the damping adjuster counterclockwise 8 positions back from full hard. This is standard position.
- 3. Make sure that both fork legs are adjusted to the same position.

Always start with the full hard position when adjusting damping.
