

Taking care of your motorcycle

- Ensure that no water enters the exhaust pipe during cleaning. Water within the exhaust pipe can cause corrosion as well as starting problems.
- Do not apply water on or into the brake system as it can lower the performance of the brakes. Always inspect the effectiveness of the brakes at a safe location after washing the motorcycle. If effectiveness of the brakes are weak, gently apply the brakes to dry the brake system.

- Avoid applying excessive pressure when waxing the motor bike. Using wax and compound on the paint or resin surfaces can result in damaging the paint, causing discolouring.
